Cotes de Gascogne - Sauvignon Blanc, France <i>A clean, fresh, medium dry white from the south of France showing floral and citrus fruit notes.</i>	£13.50
Wildwood - Chardonnay, USA <i>Lush fresh fruity white from the Sunshine State of California with ripe melon and peach flavours.</i>	£13.50
Willowglen - Riesling, Germany <i>Pale lemon in colour. Intense floral aromas combine with lime and lemon citrus characters. A flavoursome palate displaying the typical floral and citrus characters of Riesling. A crisp acid finish with a hint of sweetness makes this a refreshing wine.</i>	£16.50
Paternina Dorada Blanco - Rioja, Spain <i>Excellently made wine, dry and crisp with notes of apple and melon with a nutty finish.</i>	£15.50
Mirror Lake - Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand <i>An excellent Sauvignon from Marlborough: A lovely bouquet of fresh gooseberries leads to a crisp, refreshing palate with a lingering dry finish.</i>	£17.95
Thomas Bassot - Chablis, France <i>Unoaked Chardonnay grapes produce peach and fig flavours and steely acidity with a lingering, lightly buttery finish.</i>	£22.00

Paradise Point - White Zinfandel Blush, USA <i>Lots of lush ripe, sweet strawberry and raspberry fruit character. A real thirst quencher!</i>	£14.75
Al Verdi - Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy <i>A gentle rose hue, showing ripe berry fruit on the palate with a clean, refreshing medium-dry finish.</i>	£14.75

Sparkling Wines

Castell Llord - Cava, Spain <i>This excellent fizz has a pale lemon colour and shows a classic earthy, biscuity nose that Cava has become famous for. The palate is fruity, rounded and makes for excellent drinking. Pop a bottle and enjoy as an apéritif or partner with seafood dishes and salads.</i>	£14.95
Cielo De'or - Sparkling Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy <i>A delightful wine - the ever popular Pinot Grigio in a sparkling rosé style. Notes of strawberries, redcurrants and raspberries are evident in this dry, crisp and refreshing style of wine. Perfect as an aperitif or to accompany salads, fish dishes and even some desserts.</i>	£19.50
San Floriano - Prosecco, Italy <i>A delicate style of sparkling wine with a soft, clean fizz; hints of sherbet and well-judged acidity, lovely as an aperitif.</i>	£18.50

Red Wines

Rincon Privado - Malbec, Argentina <i>A superlative example of this grape: perfumed aromas and a velvety, full-bodied palate of ripe berries and spices.</i>	£16.00
Sepia - Pinot Noir, Chile <i>A lovely expression of this classic grape - medium in body with plenty of soft, ripe cherry and strawberry fruit and velvety finish.</i>	£16.50
Paternina Accolado Cosecha - Rioja, Spain <i>A youthful style Rioja. Not too heavy with upfront blackcurrant fruit with hints of spice and mellow oak.</i>	£15.95
Tuella - Douro Tinto, Portugal <i>A deep plummy red with ripe black fruit characteristics, herbs and spices with unmistakable aromas of fresh earth - typical of good wines from the Douro Valley.</i>	£17.50
La Roselle - Valpolicella Ripasso, Italy <i>Nicknamed 'Baby Amarone', this wine is full bodied with subtle tannins and explosive with berry fruit and spice flavours, and a savoury acidity finish.</i>	£23.50
Barossa Vines Grant Burge - Shiraz, Australia <i>A perfect example of an Australian Shiraz - lots of ripe, tarry black fruit with a lingering black pepper finish, well-balanced by oak maturation.</i>	£21.00
Chateau Lamothe 1er - Côtes de Bordeaux, France <i>An elegantly made claret, with a core of cassis and plum fruit, balanced by notes of herbs and soft tannins. An excellent accompaniment to lamb.</i>	£22.50
Carramimbre Crianza - Ribera del Duero, Spain <i>Very intense aromas of spice with hints of vanilla. Big and balanced with the spices and red fruit returning on a very pleasant finish.</i>	£25.00
Urbina Reserve Especial - Rioja, Spain <i>Black fruits, violets, spices and earthy notes abound in this magnificent, mature Rioja.</i>	£29.50
Amarone Zenato Classico - Valpolicella, Italy <i>The king of Italian reds - the grapes used for production are dried on racks prior to fermentation to make an intensely concentrated wine full of complex dark fruits, spices, bitter chocolate and a whiff of smoke.</i>	£48.00

Champagnes

Rene Lallement - 'House' selection <i>Plenty of zesty, dry citrus character and with a lively, persistent mousse, finished by touches of cream.</i>	£30.00
Perrier Jouet - Grand Brut NV <i>Fresh and pale yellow with green tints. Lively persistent bubbles with clean, soft creamy fruit, excellent intensity and a lingering finish. Elegant and balanced.</i>	£33.00
GH Mumm - 'Cordon Rouge' NV <i>Clean and subtle on the nose. Rich fruit in the mouth with toasted nuts and subtle yeasty overtones. Fresh, elegant and well balanced, with fine and long lasting bubbles.</i>	£38.00
Veuve Cliquot <i>Definitely among the top producers; a rich full-bodied Champagne with flowery, malty notes and a long, long finish.</i>	£45.00
Laurent Perrier - Cuvee Rosé Brut <i>Rich, complex soft fruit flavours. A refined and fruity great all rounder.</i>	£65.00
Dom Perignon - Brut <i>The delicate aromas and flavours of Dom Perignon really develop in the glass when savoured slowly, as floral, zesty notes give way to complex hazelnut, brioche and cream.</i>	£100.00
